Primary Responsibilities

- Supervising and ensuring the safety and well-being of all children in the classroom by following the Ohio Department of Education licensing guidelines and standards.
- Preparing lesson plans and leading a class with crafts projects, games, stories and other enrichment activities aligning with class curriculum.
- Active participation with other members of the teaching team in the implementation of curriculum, parent communication, and quality interactions with children.
- Performing documentation, anecdotal records, and daily sheets (when applicable). Maintaining a safe, clean and organized classroom environment.
- Demonstrating kindness, creativity and love for God and all children.

Qualifications

- Evidence of Christian maturity (demonstrated in attitude, action, and speech)
- Must be at least 18 years of age for Tiger Care grades Kindergarten through 6th.
- Cub Care (Pre-School, Pre-K, Kinderprep) teaching positions, a minimum of an associate's degree is preferred but not necessary.
- Dependable to work scheduled hours.
- Passion for the care and education of children
- Previous child care experience (preferred)

Requirements

- Applicants must provide a resume and three reference letters (including contact information)
- Applicants must be willing to undergo a background check, in accordance with local law/regulations.
- Upon hire, employee must provide; Copy of diploma(s), educator license (if applicable), medical statement, complete CPR/First Aid and AED Certification training, 15 hours of Professional Development, including Communicable Disease and Child Abuse Recognition and Prevention training.
